


4. You will see the image below. Login using your Giglets login details which you will find on your login sheet. The school code is woolos. Then click 'Sign in.' See the image below.



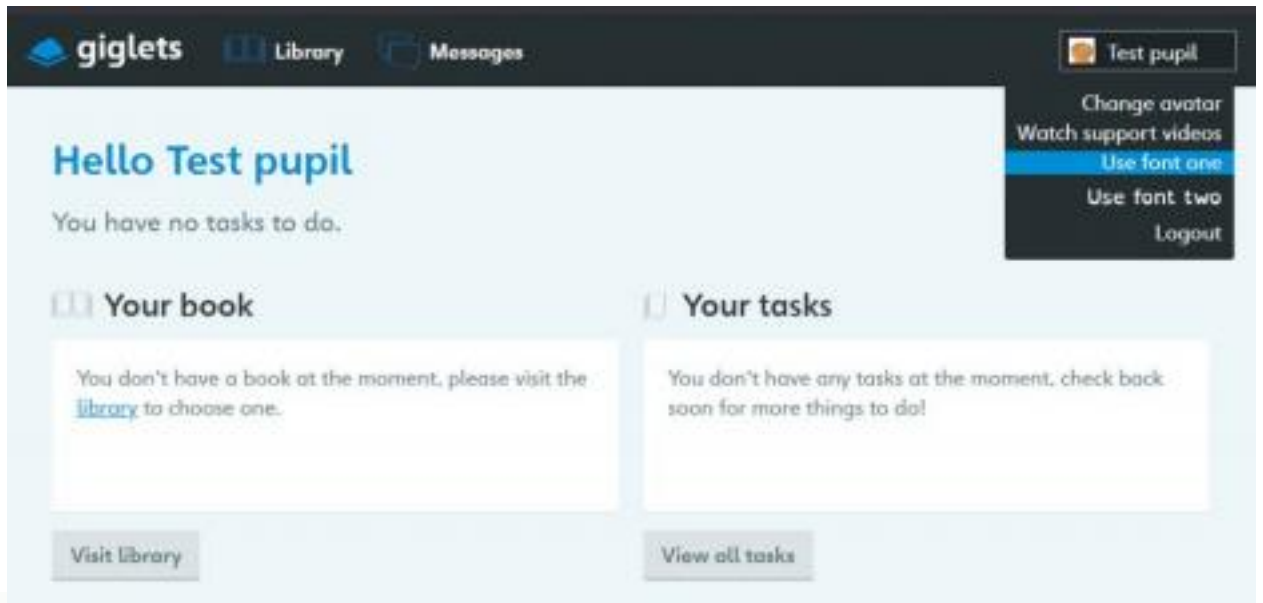

5. Click on your name/avatar in the bar at the top on the right hand side. See image below.

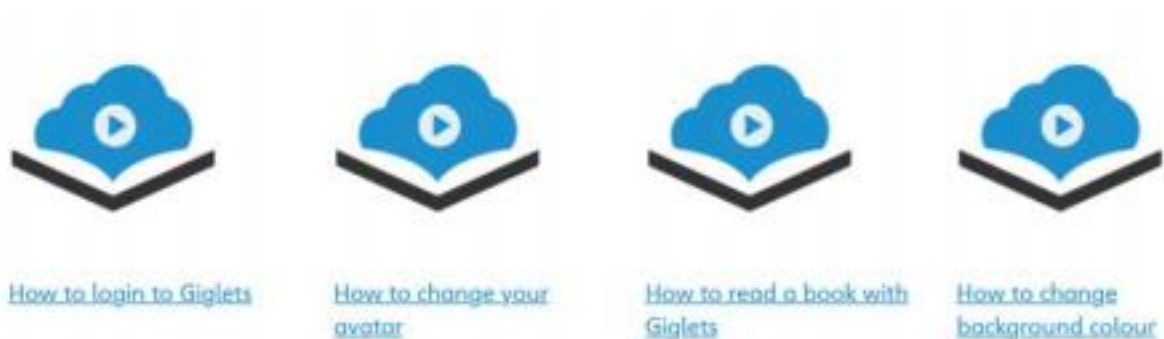
